Prior to assuming duties as President/CEO of the Upstate SC Alliance in April 2005, Johnson served nearly six years as Executive Director of the Orangeburg County Development Commission, a position to which he was named in 1999.

Hal is a member of the Board of Directors for the South Carolina Economic Developers' Association and served as its President from May 2005 to May 2006.



He is a 1988 graduate of the Citadel, with a BS in Business Administration. After graduating from the Citadel, Hal spent five years with Milliken and Company in manufacturing and sales in LaGrange, GA.

Hal was then recruited by Tietex Corporation in Spartanburg to become a Developmental Territory Manager and also spent two years with Haldon, Inc., in Charleston, SC.

Following his time at Haldon, Hal spent three years with the South Carolina Department of Commerce as a Project Manager on the National Sales Team.

In February 1997, he completed the 25th Economic Development Course at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. In January 2001, he completed the Advanced Symposium by the South Carolina Economic Developers' Association, whereby, he was declared a Certified South Carolina Economic Developer. In 2002, he was accredited by the International Economic Development Council, conducted by the College of Continuing Education at the University of Oklahoma.

He also had the honor of serving on SC Governor Mark Sanford's Transition Team sub-committees on Education, Commerce, Logistics, and Tax Incentives. In September 2003, he was named 2003 "Economic Developer of the Year" by the National Rural Economic Developers Association.

Johnson and wife Carmen have two sons, Henry Harold Johnson IV and Dohren August Johnson, and live in Greenville.
